Responsibilities and/or duties in this role:

Additionally, the outreach specialist will research potential preceptors and clinical sites in counties across the United States, make telephone calls and emails to site contacts and preceptors to secure clinical placement opportunities for student across all nurse practitioner specialty tracks, post opportunities in Moodle assist in maintaining our internal master preceptor/clinical site list. This role serves as a member of the graduate clinical placement team with oversight from the graduate clinical program assistant director.
