Who does this apply to?

Title IX specifically prohibits discrimination against a student based on pregnancy, childbirth, false pregnancy, termination of pregnancy, or recovery from any of these conditions

You have the right to:

1. Receive information about right to non-discrimination

The Title IX Coordinator is required to offer information about non-discrimination and ensure that reasonable modifications are provided.

2. Be offered reasonable modifications

Regis must provide reasonable modifications to policies, practices and procedures when needed for pregnancy or related conditions. These adjustments must be agreed to by the student and individualized to the students' needs.

3. Be offered access a separate and comparable educational program

4. Take a voluntary leave of absence and return after medical clearance

Students may take a leave with documentation from a healthcare provider, may return with the same standing they left with, and are only required to have certified clearance to return if there is a physical or health requirement to a program

5. Have access to a lactation space

6. Receive information about the grievance process



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
